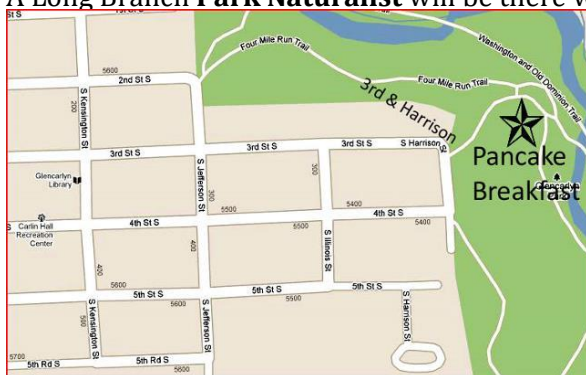
Friday Evening, June 1st


