Update on the 601 S. Carlin Springs Property

Beginning the week of October 31, crews will start preconstruction work to prepare for the upcoming demolition of the 601 S. Carlin Springs property. Over the coming weeks, activities will consist of fencing, equipment staging, and the safe abatement, removal, and disposal of hazardous materials including asbestos. The asbestos abatement will primarily be inside the building, and an environmental monitoring company will monitor the air quality to ensure safety measures are followed.

For the pre-construction activities, crews will work 7AM – 4PM Monday through Friday. Demolition of the property is expected to begin in late November and continue into early 2023.
