- Arlington Neighborhood Village has helped 817 elderly individuals over the past 10 years
- Can help with transportation, errands, household chores, technology assistance, friendly visits, walking buddies, & yard work. Rides are the most important
- They also help create community for the 55+ crowd
- Who are the people they are helping? Mostly 70+, 60% living alone and are female
- 305 active volunteers and 96% of requests are fulfilled. They also have management volunteers that work in the office
- 4 employees, individual membership is \$500 a year, under \$64k is reduced
- Each individual & volunteer goes through a background check
- Community ambassador program: help make people aware of this program
- Dixie is the neighborhood ambassador
- The future: hire social worker, raise more money, & continue great partnerships

ARNAC Report

Moses Ball Spring Project. Project has been proposed and now looking for funding. Want to improve ecological health, historical significance, access, public awareness, & collaborate on related efforts.

- **Ecological health:** animals, spring, appearance, remove junk and trash
- **Historical & Cultural:** 85,000 year old artifacts, Native American connection, tracing since Lord Fairfax, don't know when the spring house was built, historical designation
- **Public Awareness:** develop walking trail, provide benches, create self walking tour
- **Collaborate on Related Efforts:** researching and applying for grants, mitigate runoff, archeological rescue, keep on top of nature center for any tie ins
